Top 10 Write Up

T-5—Janie Goldin, C/OF, Georgia Impact 08 – Taylor

Janie is in her second full season with Kip Taylor's Georgia Impact team and continues to excel, hitting in the top part of their lineup because she puts so much pressure on opposing defenses with her elite level speed. She finished with the top batting average for Impact – Taylor last season; in over 100 games of competition, Janie batted .404 and this year is currently tops on the team in average again through her first two dozen or so games hitting an impressive .634 against 16U and 18U competition. Her blazing speed hitting from the left side of the plate butts heavy stress on the defense, but—according to Kip Taylor—the biggest difference this year has been Janie's work with Coach Lincoln Martin allowing her to hit for more power and keep the defense off balance. "She's a fixture behind the plate for our team with a big-time arm and her leadership and command of our defense has grown each tournament," says Coach Taylor. In addition to softball, Janie plays basketball and currently holds the school record and is #1 in middle school for the state of Georgia (Top 10 in country) with a long jump of 16'10." She also runs sprints and a leg on the school record 4x100m relay team. Her older brother (Cannon Goldin, 2025) is the #1 rated baseball player in the state of Georgia and recently committed to play for Ole Miss.



Kadyn Gabrels – Class of 2026 – GA Impact – Taylor

Kadyn Gabrels, an infielder for **GA Impact – Taylor**, is a powerhouse player with impressive skills both at the plate and in the field. She boasts a **batting average of .444** and a solid **fielding percentage of .931**. Kadyn's strength and consistency have earned her recognition as one of the top players in the nation.

A **2x 7A State Champion at Buford High School**, Kadyn's leadership on the field has been instrumental in her team's success. She is also an **Academic Letter recipient** and an active member of **FCA**, showcasing her dedication to both academics and athletics.

Despite a shoulder injury that sidelined her briefly, Kadyn came back strong, hitting a **home run** in her first game back. Her coach, **Kip Taylor**, commends her toughness and versatility, saying, "Kadyn is tough as nails and is extremely consistent both offensively and defensively. She is one of the best changeup hitters in the country."

Kadyn has committed to **South Carolina**, where she's expected to continue making an impact at the next level.

T-59—Hayley Beth Brewer, P/IF, Fury Premier 2027 – Robinson

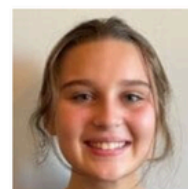
Hayley Beth has really come into her own over the last year as one of the top pitchers in the 2027 class. She consistently throws in the 62-to-65 mph range per Coach Leslie Robinson and "can place her fastball on demand in any location and follow it up with a devastating change up that she can deliver to any part of the zone in any count." Hayley Beth has also demonstrated an impressive drop and screwball that "makes the hitter look silly and gets plenty of strikeouts and ground outs," per coach, "generating a substantial amount of swings and misses, strikeouts, and weak contact." Offensively, the young athlete—who is also a standout on the basketball court and earned All-County for her middle school and made the West Tennessee All-Star Team—brings power to the plate and is always a threat to change the game with one swing. Last Fall, she batted .478 and had 56 K's in 47 innings with a 1.60 ERA.

T-100—Leah Wangaard, C/UT, TN Fury Premier 2027 – Robinson

Leah is a multi-sport athlete who also shines in volleyball and has a 4.0 GPA in the classroom. She was one of only two 8th graders that got called up to play Junior Varsity for Mortimer Jordan (Ala.) High softball this Spring—the same high school that produced Haylie McCleney. In the first half of 2022, she played with the Mojo – Palmer team and helped her squad to at Top 5 finish at Colorado Sparkler and Top 13 finish at PGF Nationals. She has been a two-time USSSA Select30 Direct Invite and Fury Head Coach Charlie Robinson states: "I have been working with Leah in catching lessons since she was in 10U and there has never been any question as to if this kid was going to make it big. Her work ethic has always been, by far, the best I have ever seen in such a young kid." Last Fall, Leah batted .478 with a .976 fielding percentage, catching 60 innings and allowing just two passed balls.

T-75—Reese Covington, IF/OF, Georgia Impact Premier 09 – O’Neal

Reese has been a nice addition this season for Head Coach Chad O’Neal’s team after coming over from a talented Atlanta Premier squad. She is an impressive athlete standing 5-foot-11 with plus speed and an excellent arm and is a true utility player recording innings at all the positions except pitcher and catcher. At the plate, Reese provides gap-to-gap power and, last year batted .418. Coach O’Neal explains: “We expect her to continue that pace with us this Spring and believe her versatility and strong bat will be vital as we make another run at PGF Nationals.”
